

Wedding Budget - Worksheet

This is a tool to help you plan and prioritize the areas that are important to your wedding day. First column shows average costs we are currently seeing in the PNW for each of the various services. It is possible to find services for less than what is reflected here, but it might indicate a lower level of experience and professionalism. Services can run well past the high side of these averages as well, so be sure to keep a close eye on the budget as you plan. Prices fluctuate often. This should not serve as an assurance that you will find services at these exact price points.
